## 1.0 DEFINITIONS

1.1 “System” means the SystemConcepts computer equipment you acquired from SystemConcepts, Inc. and on which the Software was pre-installed or onto which it is to be installed.

1.2 “Software” means the computer program(s) acquired from SystemConcepts, Inc. and installed on the System or any Revisions thereto. This may include programs written by SCI as well as operating systems and application programs written by others which have been provided to you or installed on the System by SystemConcepts, Inc. Software will be provided to you in object code form only. The Software includes any disks or media on which it is recorded, any printed Documentation or any “on-line” or electronic Documentation.

1.3 “Documentation” means the materials accompanying the Software which describe its functions and how to install and use the Software.

1.4 “Revision” means any correction, modification, update, enhancement, or new version of the Software or Documentation provided to you by SystemConcepts, Inc.

1.5 “You” or “your” refers to the end user licensed to use the Software under this EULA.

1.6 “SCI” means SystemConcepts, Inc., a North Carolina corporation.

## 2.0 LICENSE

2.1 SystemConcepts, Inc. hereby grants you a license to use the Software subject to the following terms and conditions.

2.2 The Software is licensed, not sold. SCI hereby grants you a non-exclusive, terminable, limited license to use the Software on the System(s) for your own internal business purposes. No other right or license is granted or implied. You agree to not modify, copy, distribute or otherwise disclose the Software without the prior written consent of SCI. You further agree not to reverse engineer, disassemble, or de-compile the Software. This license shall terminate when you no longer own or You cease to use the System(s) on which You are licensed to use the Software.

2.3 You may not duplicate or copy the Software except that you may make a single copy of the Software for use solely for archival purposes. The archival copy must bear the copyright notices appearing in the original.

**2.4** You may not sell, lease, rent, assign, sublicense or transfer the Software except that you may transfer all of your rights under this EULA as part of a sale or transfer of the System(s). Such a sale or transfer may only be made if you retain no copies of the Software, you transfer all of the Software (including any media, archival copies, upgrades and Documentation) and the recipient agrees to abide by the terms of this EULA. An upgrade may not be transferred unless you transfer all prior versions of the Software. ## **Privacy and Security Policy**

This policy discloses SCI's privacy guidelines for this SCI web site.

### **Information Gathered**

User information and site activity data is collected throughout the web site, including domains, browsers, and pages accessed. This information is used for standard reporting purposes and to improve the site content and display. Information required for the purchase and delivery of SCI products and services, to allow SCI to contact customers when necessary, to tailor the user experience, and to protect SCI from fraud, may be collected throughout the site. Names, shipping addresses, billing addresses, credit card numbers and expiration dates, e-mail addresses, and voice and fax telephone number are among the information collected.

#### **A. Registered Users**

### **A. Encryption**

SCI uses industry standard encryption security measures to protect the privacy and integrity of the information you provide to us once it is received on our systems. We understand that using web site commerce can cause concern. Unfortunately, when you submit information about yourself to SCI over the Internet, the information may travel over many systems that are not under the control of SCI. While SCI tries to protect the information you provide us, we can not ensure the secrecy of any information that you transmit to us. You transmit information to SCI at your own risk.

Your purchase transactions with us are secure. They will always be encrypted even when you may think they are not. No one will be able to see your order or your credit card number from our site. We can also assure you that we will not use or sell the information that you place on the order form. SCI's transaction frames are fully SSL encrypted. Encryption ensures that transaction information is sent securely but has a significant performance tradeoff in the browser environment. You may have noticed that the SCI site employs a framed metaphor for easier navigation and more efficient page updates. With this in mind SCI selectively places SSL encryption on only those forms and frames that need to be encrypted (e.g., the checkout).

Since things like our product selectors and menus don't need to be slowed down by SSL we do not employ it there. Unfortunately (but for obvious reasons) browsers won't show the safe "KEY" or "LOCK" unless each and every frame on the page is SSL encrypted. Thus, if only one frame is encrypted, the browser correctly reports that not everything you are looking at is "safe". However, the absence of the "lock" or "key" does not mean that the information you are looking at is not encrypted. You can verify that a frame is SSL encrypted by right-clicking within the frame and looking at the frame info or properties (ie. Found in the "View" menu in Netscape and the "File" menu in Internet Explorer). Doing this within SCI's checkout pages will indeed show that this information is being sent encrypted.

## **B. Password**

It is vital for you to protect your password and account information. You should not share this information with anyone other than your employer. You retain sole responsibility for maintaining the secrecy of your password or other account information.
